



Campbell Horses Boarding Contract/Barn Rules

Customer hours are 7 am to 9 pm each day. Closing time may be extended during warmer weather and will be posted if changes are made. The arena(s) are open for boarder use – unless there is an event scheduled. An email notification will be sent to all boarders in this case and/or it will be posted in the tack area prior to event. Any arena not in use during an event is available for riding unless otherwise stated.

Safety First – in case of human emergency call 911

NO SMOKING ON PREMISES

NO DOGS on grounds (unless on a leash to potty and back into vehicle)

ALL Guests are required to sign a waiver upon arrival. Guests **MUST BE** accompanied by a boarder each visit.

Instructors/Trainers: We offer facility rental for clinicians to do weekend or weeklong clinics, lessons, etc. For rates and requirements please visit our website. Due to liability issues we do not permit outside instructors and/or trainers for daily/weekly riding instruction and training – however you are more than welcome to travel off site for instruction.

Farrier: We have a professional farrier who comes on a regular schedule (Marcus Swartz) and we welcome you to utilize his services. You have the option to use a farrier of your choice, but we do ask that cleanup and our barn rules are upheld.

Veterinarians: Your chosen veterinarian is welcome to come anytime – however we ask you notify us of the appointment when possible especially if special arrangements are needed.

All persons under 18 are required to wear a riding helmet. Helmets are encouraged for all riders/disciplines.

Order and Cleanliness of the barn, tack room, and surrounding areas is of high importance. We ask that you **promptly** clean up your horses' manure, grooming debris, urine, etc., from the tack up area, and outside tie area, and arena. Buckets, scoops, brooms can all be located in the tack area and in several locations throughout barn(s).

Please avoid tying to the arena fence or paddock fences, utilize the tie/grooming area(s). Do not leave horses unattended who paw or are destructive.

If you don't know..... Ask (cell phone numbers for owners listed below)

No feeding or treats are to be given to non-owned horses

Shavings, hay, etc. is not for boarders to handle/take without consent. Please let us know if you need to buy hay or shavings for travel etc.

Horses are housed depending on temperament, sex, health needs, etc., if you have a special request please discuss with Cameron or Jolene. For the safety and well-being of horses and humans; Horses that are difficult or destructive may be required to move or be unable to stay if a solution can't be reached.

Lessons with Jo are to start at specified time. Lessons are semi-private. Riding in the arena during a lesson is permitted unless otherwise posted. 24hr notice is required for lesson cancellations.

ALWAYS close gates, shut off lights, close doors, and pick up after yourself and your horse.

Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult. No children are permitted to roam barn area, pastures, etc. alone.

The driveway maximum speed is **10 mph**. We have children, livestock, and pets to keep safe. Please use caution.

Campbell Horses LLC, Cameron and Jolene Campbell are not liable for injury or death of a person or equine. If you desire an insurance policy on your horse, please contact an equine insurance carrier.

We reserve the right to charge for any damages you or your horse might cause to our facilities (stall, barn, fencing, arena, etc.). Normal wear and tear is excluded.

Health Certificate if from Out of State

ANNUAL VACCINATIONS AND NEG. COGGINS ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL HORSES

First month's board is due at drop off. Board is due by the 5th of each month. We require 30 days' notice prior to departure.
